

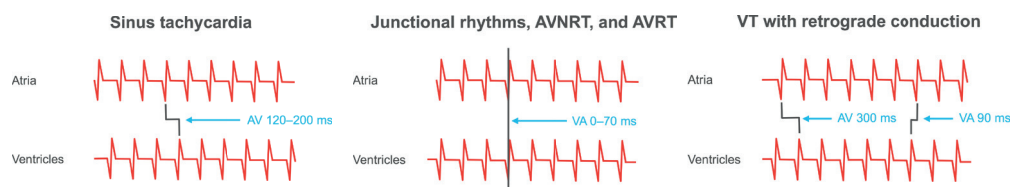
DISCRIMINATING BETWEEN DIFFERENT ARRHYTHMIAS

PR pattern analysis

Key take-away points

- PR pattern analysis is specifically used for arrhythmias with equal number of atrial events and ventricular events.
- Withholds therapy if there is a normal PR interval, or if the VA time suggests an atrioventricular reentrant tachycardia (AVRT) or atrioventricular nodal reentrant tachycardia (AVNRT).
- Delivers therapy if a ventricular tachycardia (VT) with retrograde conduction is suspected.

1:1 tachycardias
Sinus tachycardia
Junctional tachycardia
Atrioventricular nodal reentrant tachycardia (AVNRT)
Atrioventricular reentrant tachycardia (AVRT)
Ventricular tachycardia with retrograde conduction
