


What should I screen before weaning my patient?






Screening before weaning

Before weaning you need to screen your patient to make sure they meet the following criteria.


1. Oxygenation status

 $SpO_2 \ge 90\%$ on $FiO_2 \le 40\%$ PEEP $\le 5 \text{ cmH}_2O$




3. Hemodynamic status

No active myocardial infarction No (or low) vasopressor infusion



2. Ventilation status

< 35 breaths / minute



4. Sedation status

No neuromuscular blocking agents
