1. Use the A, B, C strategy to answer questions effectively.

A, B, C strategy:

- <u>Anticipate the questions.</u>
- Be <u>b</u>rief in your answers.
- Keep <u>c</u>ontrol of the topic and audience.
- 2. Be honest if you do not know the answer to a question.

Options to use for answers you do not know:


- Ask if someone else knows.
- Arrange to follow-up and provide the answer.
- Tell the person if you know where to find the information.





- The best way to get questions is to say, "Who has the first questions?"
- A good way to start the Q & A is to say, "A question I am often asked is..."
